- Premier Medical Group has been contracted to administer the distribution of COVID19 vaccine in semi- urban and rural communities in Pima County. This includes Green Valley. We will pass on information as it becomes available.
- The State Retail Program will supply Covid-19 vaccine to six (6) pharmacy locations in Pima County, including Fry's Food Store at 15950 S. Rancho Sahuarita Blvd and Safeway at 260 W. Continental Rd in Green Valley.

NOTE: There is no known date as to when the pharmacies will be vaccinating or the quantity of vaccine they will receive.
