The Traffic & Arroyos Committee worked with HOAs along Camino Del Sol, Pima County Maintenance Committee, and Supervisor Steve Christy's Office to alleviate "potholes" along Camino Del Sol that caused numerous traffic safety concerns. These "pothole disturbances" were caused by the County's contractor in preparation for the replacement of Camino Del Sol from Calle Tres to Via Del Pulpo and Calle de la Adelfa to Desert Jewel Loop. This work is scheduled to be completed within the next couple of months.
