Commander Kenyon: The Commander gave details on new text scams and cautioned everyone to be cautious. He also gave details on the continued effort to find a missing Green Valley man.

President Kenyon: President Kenyon discussed the Health and Human Services Committee efforts to find solutions to the problem of after hour and weekend resident's needs, and the possibility of a community wide forum to address the problem. She also gave an overview of the difference between GVC and GV Foundation. President Kenyon also gave details on upcoming forums.

David McAllister Romo: David stated new projects are in the works to engage the community. He mentioned a new staff member will be sought. He also gave details on bringing interns into GV to learn and add new ideas to GVC. He mentioned the upcoming launching of the new website.
