Tom – Pima Cty original proposal was to supply a team of contracted med. Personal for each supervisor district. **Question:** Would GV need a visiting nurse? **Response:** Still need after hours support and messaging to those at risk at home. Mold issues in townhomes. Several complaints about HOA/HOA mgt companies not doing anything. DEQ and PC Health do NOT investigate. Only recourse is through State Dept of Real estate

Chris: 1. VAS is seeing "burned out "caregivers – both in home related and professional providers

2. Homeless in cars parking overnight in driveways of uninhabited homes
