ADOT: No Rep

PDOT: Upgrade signal at S La Canada & Continental with blind controls.

- Pick up trash Camino Casa Verde.
- Highpoint HOA submitted work for crack seal. Also complained of speeders on Camino Casa Verde.
- SeeClickFix to GVC for work order than to contractor to perform.
- Federal code changes to roads in Green Valley Grant. Money available to do work.

Town of Sahuarita: Quail Crossing, Judge gave 24 months to get the railway set up with the traffic lights.

- Nogales Hwy & Quail Crossing will get left turn signals by years end.
\$92,000 upgrade for green light to emergency vehicles.
- Campbell Ave funding? Nothing yet.

Pima County Sheriff's Dept: 161 Stops, 53 Tickets & 7 Collisions.

SAV: 3500 hours, 90 incidents, 20 Park patrols, & 900 homes checks.

- Fire dept. Pancake breakfast.
- Octoberfest at Canoa Ranch.
- Artisan Fair
- Tour De Tuson

PTAC: County only has \$20 mil. for 2024.

- 60% to arterial & collectors 40% to local.
- Looking for new funding.
- Tier 2 money approved for Sonoran Corridor.

RTA CAC: Voted on projects to go to supervisors and results should be at the next meeting.

RTA Cart: 2026-2046 budget should be \$2.43 billion.

- \$1.43 billion to spend on projects after warehousing.
- 2006 -2026 transfer 4 projects to next at \$430 mil leaving \$1 billion for the rest of the projects for 2026-2046.

RTA Transit Working Group: New booklet in November.

Bicycle Committee: Looking at wanting to improve Whitehouse Canyon RD and Campbell Ave.

New Business: Whitehouse and De La Canoa new church. Also 146 lots are/to be developed down De La Canoa. Also, Campbell Ave and Whitehouse intersection. (looking for PCDOT warrants for these intersections)

- Electric vehicle hearing on Oct. 18, 2023.

Community Input: David Palmer of Desert Meadows wanted to know how to get the drainage to drain along the alleyway by ADOT maintenance.
